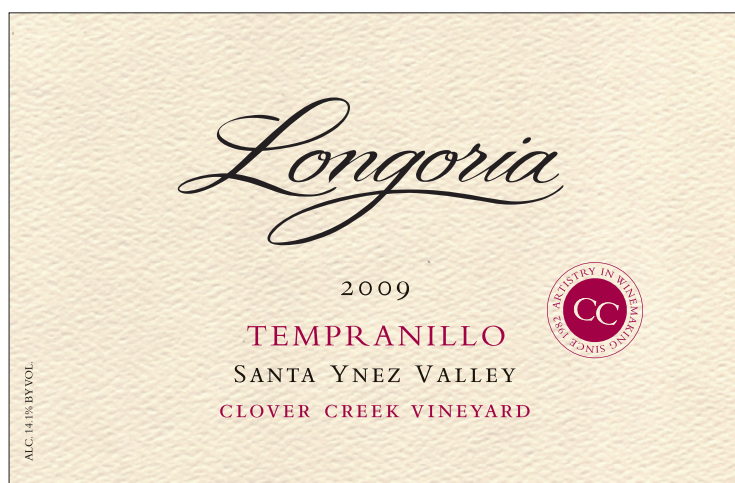

Vineyard Tempranillo (Santa Ynez  
Valley); \$36.

“(aged in 100% American oak): Ruby-red. Dried cherry and redcurrant aromas are complicated by cracked pepper and vanilla nuances. Fresh, finely etched red fruit preserve flavors are firmed by dusty tannins, with a floral note coming up with air. This suave, oak-spiced wine finishes with very good clarity and sweet persistence. There’s an elegance to this wine that recalls Rioja but the intense fruit hearkens to Ribera del Duero.” - Josh Raynolds
